What Is Winterim?

The 2021 Traditional Undergraduate Winterim at Lancaster Bible College is made of week-long concentrated class sessions that will meet for four hours per day. Course time will be supplemented through Canvas & each class will be delivered in a blended course. The Winterim term is part of the regular academic program and all courses earn credit toward the various degree programs of the college.

Lancaster Bible College is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools and the Association for Biblical Higher Education. The college reserves the right to cancel any course which has insufficient enrollment.

The standards and guidelines of the college, as stated in the regular college handbook also apply to the Winterim sessions.

Payment Terms:
