All undergraduate, degree-seeking students taking at least twelve (12) academic credits are required to live in College-owned housing as *Resident* students.

*Commuter* students may include full-time undergraduate students who are living with a parent or legal guardian within forty (40) miles of the College, OR who are married and living with a spouse, OR who are residing with children, OR who are at least twenty-five (25) years of age.

# Premium Single Rooms

# Housing Agreement Release

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**To be considered for release from the Housing Agreement, a student must meet the following criteria:**

- Meet the eligibility requirements to have Commuter status
- Complete at least 90 credits by the start of the Fall term, AND/OR
- Be at least 23 years of age by the start of the Fall term,
- AND be in good standing with the College
- Students seeking exceptions to the Housing Agreement must contact [residencelife@lbc.edu](mailto:residencelife@lbc.edu)

Requests for release from the Housing Agreement must be approved in writing by the office of Residence Life. Requests for release are reviewed in the Spring semester for the following academic year. **Requests to be released received after the advertised deadline, including mid-year, will not be approved.**

The College reserves the right to limit the number of students who are released from the Housing Agreement each year.

The College also reserves the right to revoke approval for release if the student does not successfully complete 90 credits prior to the start of the fall semester, or is no longer in good standing with the College.

Students approved for release must submit a copy of their off-campus lease to Residence Life, as well as disclose the names of their intended roommates.

Students who break the housing agreement by moving to off-campus housing without the express written approval of Residence Life will be responsible for all housing charges assessed for the semester he/she breaks the Housing Agreement.

# Housing Agreement Release: Additional Information

Students can apply to be released from the Housing Agreement through the Star-Rez housing application available on LBC Mobile and the Student Portal. A lease does not change the status of a request; thus a student should consider waiting for approval before signing a lease.

**Returning students** who are requesting approval to live off campus must make the request by the end of housing selection in the spring.

**New students** who are seeking approval to live off campus must fill out the approval form before August 1. Late enrollment students should talk to the office of Residence Life as soon as possible, whether they are seeking on- or off-campus housing.
