



SUMMER HOUSING 2021

Housing Criteria

Summer housing students must be enrolled in Fall 2021 classes at LBC. Summer housing will take place in Weber Hall (those staying 1-3 weeks) or Weber Apartments (those staying 4+ weeks) Additionally, students must meet at least one of the following requirements:

1. Student enrolled in a summer 2021 course, including internship for credit
 - \$50/week rate billed at the beginning of the summer
 2. Students employed on campus for a minimum of 490 hours (14 weeks at 35 hours/week)
 - No housing cost
 - Housed in Weber Apartments
 3. Students who would be literally homeless except for on-campus housing, including international students unable to travel home, who are NOT employed on campus for a minimum of 490 hours
 - \$50/week rate billed at the beginning of the summer
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Billing

The summer housing term is May 9- August 28 (16 weeks).
Billing is per week, Sunday - Saturday.

Students will be billed for the full period of their stay prior to the start of summer housing. Bills must be paid in full or a payment plan developed with the Solution Center in order to move into summer housing.

Student employees who do not complete the full 490 hours of on campus work will be charged for housing at a rate of \$50/week at the end of the summer for weeks when the 35/week average was not met.

Example: A student who only works 400 hours will be charged for 3 weeks of housing ($490 - 400 = 90$; $90/35 = 2.57$)
